DR. J. ROSAI #7 24 year old asymptomatic male with resection of an encapsulated anterior superior mediastinal mass discovered by routine x-ray.

DIAGNOSIS: Convoluted lymphblastic lymphoma.

DR. L. LU (1) 9997-76 Resection of a paravertebral mass in a 60 year old male with back pain.

DIAGNOSIS: Extraosseous nonfunctional plasmacytoma. 2

(2) 2514-77 Bowel resection in a 68 year old female with right lower quadrant abdominal pain.

DIAGNOSIS: Tuberculosis ileitis. 3

(3) 173-77 Uterine curettings in a 40 year old female with vaginal bleeding.

DIAGNOSIS: Oral contraceptive - associated focal atypical endometrial hyperplasia with squamous metaplasia. 4

(4) 2-75 Cervical LN in a 23 year old female with intermittent pyrexia.

DIAGNOSIS: Nonspecific reactive hyperplasia. 5

ADDENDUM: A late LN biopsy proved to be angioimmunoblastic lymphadenopathy.

DR. R. STARK (1) 4934-77 60 year old male with swelling over mandibular angle of two months duration.

DIAGNOSIS: Lipomatosis of parotid gland in an alcoholic 6

(2) 5123-77 41 year old male with resection of a gastric tumor.

DIAGNOSIS: Leiomyoblastoma (Epithelioid leiomyoma) 7

DR. W.S. HWANG	77-10212	28 year old female with postpartum hemorrhage.
	DIAGNOSIS:	Placenta increta 8
DR. W. CHOW	77-12890-1	35 year old female with left vulva tumor.
	DIAGNOSIS:	Adenoid cystic carcinoma arising from Bartholin Glands. 9
DR. D. OWEN	77-12152-1	60 year old male with an L4 extramedullary extraosseous tumor compressing nerve roots. Otherwise well.
	DIAGNOSIS:	Granulocytic sarcoma vs eosinophilic granuloma. (Naphthol AS-D chloroacetate esterase to be done). 10
DR. R. BANERJEE	(1) 449-4423	53 year old female with a thyroid nodule.
	DIAGNOSIS:	Follicular adenoma with focal well differentiated follicular carcinoma. (Autopsy 28 years later showed metastases not responsible for her death).
	(2) 77-2587-1	62 year old female with an upper left lip cyst.
	DIAGNOSIS:	Monomorphic adenoma of minor salivary gland. 12
DR. S.C. LAUHLAN	577-4527	83 year old female with a polypoid vaginal mass.
	DIAGNOSIS:	Malignant mixed mesodermal tumor (carcinosarcoma) vs adenosarcoma. 13
DR. B. JOHNSTON	3703-77	A 19 year old female Dental Assistant with abdominal enlargement and ankle edema of 3 months' duration. Radioisotopic liver scan suggested a right lobe tumor. At laparotomy the spleen was enlarged to about four times normal size.
	DIAGNOSIS:	Granulomatous hepatitis of unknown etiology (after consultation with Dr. P. Scheuer and K. Ishak. Awaiting consultation report of Prof. J.B. Gibson, University of Hong Kong, Co-ordinator of WHO panel for Liver Tumors.) (Angiograms suggested only a diffuse arteritis with external iliac artery obstruction). 14
