Dr. R. Banerjee: 1. 78-6706---71 year old female with pathological fracture 2 days prior to biopsy.

DIAGNOSIS: Fibroblastic osteosarcoma

2. 79-1457---51 year old male with obstructive lesion of proximal ureter.

DIAGNOSIS: Sarcomatoid invasive poorly differentiated transitional cell carcinoma

Dr. W. Chow: Peripheral blood smear from a 34 year old female with anemia and thrombocytopenia.

CONTRIBUTOR'S DIAGNOSIS: Burkitt's lymphoma (from bone marrow biopsy).

CONSENSUS DIAGNOSIS: Acute leukemia, unspecified, with leukoerythroblastic anemia, subleukemic phase.

Dr. L. Lu: 1. 9350-76---73 year old female with a L. inguinal skin nodule.

DIAGNOSIS: Malignant "histiocytic" lymphoma of skin.

2. 8786-76---70 year old female with a 0.7 cm. in diameter firm nodule of the thigh region.

DIAGNOSIS: Localized granulomatous panniculitis.

Dr. J. Rosai: Case 4-----R. testicular tumour in a 32 year old male

DIAGNOSIS: Anaplastic seminoma.

Dr. R. Stark: 1. 907-79---A cyst of the forehead skin in a 57 year old male.

DIAGNOSIS: Apocrine hidrocystoma

Dr. R. Stark: 2. 2413-79---Recurrent lesions of the lower lip in a 39 year old female.

DIAGNOSIS: Pustule stage of Herpes virus infection.

Dr. W.S. Hwang: A-79-2-4---Neonatal death with transposition of great vessels and jejunoileal atresia.

DIAGNOSIS: Ischemic enteropathy.

Dr. D. Owen: 79-2568---L. cervical lump of 6 months' duration in a 47 year old male.

DIAGNOSIS: Hashimoto's thyroiditis, fibrous variant.

Dr. H. Benediktsson: 79-2992-R. forearm lesion in a young adult male.

DIAGNOSIS: Subcutaneous pyogenic granuloma

Dr. N. Pettigrew: 79-4658---77 year old male with inguinal lymphadenopathy.

DIAGNOSIS: Malignant lymphoma, nodular poorly differentiated lymphocytic type with sclerosis. (Majority would classify as mixed lymphocytic-histiocytic type but would require additional sections).

Dr. F.W. Orr: 79-3142-2---Uterine curettings in a 60 year old female who presented with the sudden onset of vaginal bleeding.

CONTRIBUTOR'S DIAGNOSIS: Carcinoid tumour of cervix uteri.

CONSENSUS DIAGNOSIS: Epithelioid leiomyosarcoma (confirmed by EM)

Dr. J.L. Wright: 1. JLW-1---Nipple line lesion in a mature female

DIAGNOSIS: Pleomorphic adenoma (mixed tumour) of cranial mammary gland.

2. A-27113-A---42 year old female with dyspnea of many years duration. Angiography showed poor perfusion of the lower lobes with large lung volumes. Serum protein electrophoresis indicated low  $\alpha_1$  globulin concentrations.

DIAGNOSIS: Pulmonary emphysema associated with  $\alpha_1$  antitrypsin deficiency.

Dr. B. Johnston:      2003-79--55 year old female with multiple pulmonary nodules, an abnormal liver scan and lesions of of the L. femoral head and posterior R. 10th rib by bone scan. The osteolytic rib lesion was biopsied.

DIAGNOSIS: Mesenchymal chondrosarcoma probably primary in rib.
