Dr. Lauchlan	S79-3915	32 Female with bilateral borderline serous cystadenomata. Slide from omentum.	Endosalpingiosis. Fat necrosis due to recent surgery. Ref: Tutschka, B and Lauchlan, S.C. Endosalpingiosis. Obs and Gyne. In press.
Dr. Banerjee	79-3791 -1	29 female. Abnormal smears. Cone biopsy.	Combined in situ epidermoid and adenocarcinoma. Ref: 1. Lauchlan, S.C. and Penner, D.W. Cancer 20: 12, 2250-54, Dec./67. 2. Quizilbash, A.; A.J.C.P. August 1975. 3. Weisbrot et al; Cancer 29: 5, 155-70. May 1972. COMMENT: some members felt that a less malignant diagnosis would be in order.

9	Dr. Johnston	3544-79	55 female. Lump from UOQ right breast.	Adenocystic carcinoma
10	Dr. Benediktsson	11185 -2	69 male with a 1.2 cm. nodule of the right eyelid for 6 months.	Sebaceous carcinoma of
11	Dr. Owen	73-19025 -12	49 female. Anal discomfort and ulceration for many years. Recent exacerbation with bleeding.	Squamous cell carcinoma Crohn's disease.
12	Dr. Hwang	A78-189-6	Female 3 months. 820 Del. by C-section at 33 weeks for severe PET. Respiratory distress syndrome, progressed to Wilson-Mikity syndrome. E coli septicemia terminally. Ileum and cecum appeared congested and hemorrhagic.	Localized Shwartzman reaction - necrotizing enterocolitis.
13	Dr. Orr	79B95	Male 70 with dyspnoea, abdominal pain and hemoptysis. Treatment for cardiac arrhythmia with Rythmadan. Died suddenly 2 days after admission. Bp 80/60, blood sugar 13mg%. SGOT 4080IU/l.	Acetaminophen and Rythmadan toxicity.
