H. Benediktsson 80/14260	Male 10. Lesion on the lt. buttock	Cellular blue nevus
E. Ravinsky 78/21716 (A) 80/14670 (B)	Lesion on nose. 64 yrs old woman	Squamous cell carcinoma, spindle cell type with metastasis

W.S. Hwang A80/126	3 month old baby, found dead at home in early morning. Seen by family pediatrician few days earlier for coryza.	Whooping cough
R. Stark 8036F-80	Female aged 54, Rt. upper quadrant mass. On laporatomy, mass 12 cms along its longest axis found adherent to liver and adjacent tissues	Malignant fibrous histiocytoma
8461A-80	Male aged 65. Found on omentum during operation fo abdominal aortic aneurysm	Benign papillary mesothelioma
B. Johnston 80-191-40	62 yrs old male. Previous surgery rt. parietal lobe. Yellowish discoloration in this area at autopsy	Metastatic bronchi-alveolar carcinoma
R. Banerjee A-6310	Male 60's Upper lobe rt. lung (most sections do not show the pathologic changes)	Bronchiolar-alveolar carcinoma (80-191 is from the same man)
80-5043	Female, 11 yrs old. Terminal painless hematuria. Bladder biopsy	Cystitis due to S. Mankoni
T. Cooney 80-28105E	2 yrs old. A testicular mass found at hernia repair	Gonadal stromal tumor, Sertoli cell type, ?malignant. No hormone effects.

Dx. Small cell carcinoma, probably neuroendocrine origin

21 yrs old young man had experienced chills and fever
with vomiting and a fainting spell. At autopsy the mass
was found around the aorta and pulmonary artery.
Dx. Undifferentiated small cell sarcoma, type undetermined.
